1. Two Sections
2. Two containers of cut comb
3. One Frame of comb honey (suitable for extraction)
4. Two 1 lb. Jars of light honey.
5. Two 1 lb. Jars of medium honey
6. Two 1 lb. Jars of dark honey
7. Two 1 lb. Jars of chunk honey
8. Two 1 lb. Jars of granulated honey
9. Two 1 lb. Jars of creamed honey
10. Two 1 lb. Jars of ling heather honey
11. Six 1 lb jars of any type of honey, all the same, to be shown as offered for sale. All jars must be labelled with the exhibitors own labels in accordance with E.U. Regulations. One jar **only** must have a tamper proof label.



SUPREME HONEY in Classes 4 - 11

12. **NOVICE CLASS.** One 1 lb jar of any type of honey or one section of honey. (Competitors who have previously won a first prize are ineligible)
13. **GIFT CLASS.** One section or one 1lb jar of any type of honey. (Exhibits in this class will be disposed of at the discretion of the show committee)
14. Six 1 oz. blocks of beeswax.
15. **Miscellaneous:** An interesting or instructive exhibit or new invention relating to bees (not previously awarded a prize).

16. Honey Cake. Made with 8 oz of sr. flour, 6 oz. Irish Honey, 4 oz. Butter or margarine, 2 eggs and a pinch of salt. Bake in a 6 ½ " to 7 ½ " circular tin.
17. Fruit Honey Cake. Made with 8 oz of sr. flour, 6 oz. Irish Honey, 4 oz. Butter or margarine, 2 eggs, 6 oz. sultanas and a pinch of salt. Bake in a 6 ½ " to 7 ½ " circular tin
18. Toffee, Caramel or Sweetmeats (any recipe that includes honey)
19. 6 Small biscuits (any recipe that includes honey)

Confined classes

Classes 20—23 exhibitors who have previously won 5 first prizes are ineligible.

20. Two 1 lb. Jars of light honey
21. Two 1 lb. Jars of medium honey
22. Two Sections of honey
23. One 1 lb jar of any type of honey. Competitors must have attended the Royal County Beekeepers' Beginners Course in 2010 or 2011. (Competitors who have previously won a first prize are ineligible)

25. Two 1 lb. Jars of medium honey

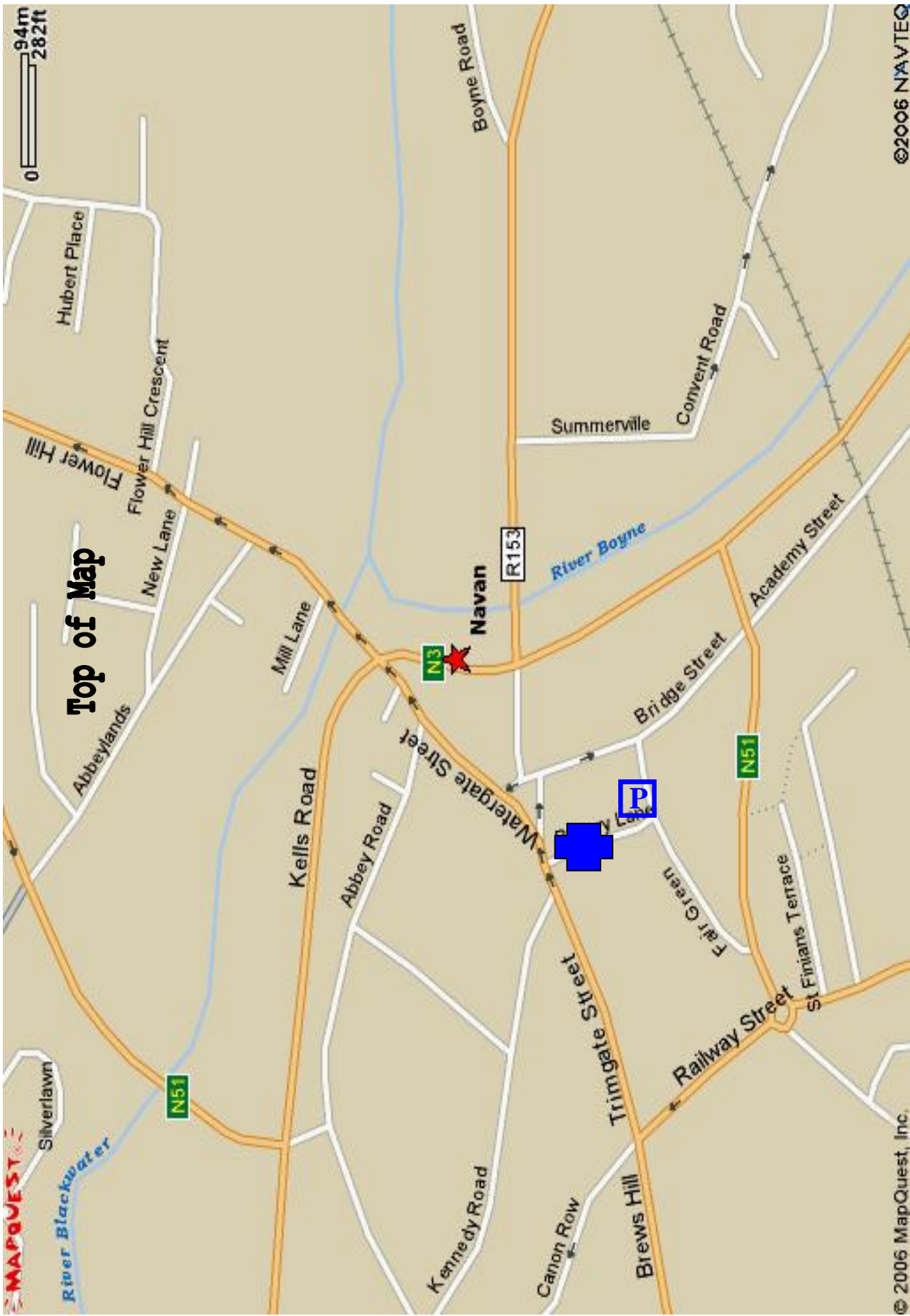
RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. Exhibits must be brought to The Community Centre, Navan on Sunday 9th October 2011 between 11.00 am and 1.30pm. Judging will commence at 2pm.
2. An exhibit shall not be entered in more than one class.
3. An exhibitor shall not be entitled to more than one prize in any one class.
4. Exhibits in class 13 become the property of the Association and will be disposed of during the show to defray expenses.
5. The decision of the Judge(s) shall be final.
6. The Judge(s) reserve the right not to award all or any of the prizes in any class.
7. The decision of the show committee on any matter relating to the show (except Judging) shall be final.
8. A label or any other distinguishing mark may not be placed on any exhibit, except Class 11. Numbers provided by the show Secretary, shall be placed approx. 12.5mm from the bottom of jars and with sections and beeswax one number stuck to the exhibit, and one to the container.
9. Wax may be exhibited polished or unpolished at the discretion of the exhibitor.
10. Entries shall be made on the form provided. Entry fee €2 per entry, except class 13 where there is no fee.

11. Prizes will be presented immediately after the judging has finished.
12. Extracted Honey must be exhibited in plain round, straight sided, clear glass 454g jars with plain gold lacquered screw top or twist off lids.
13. All honey and wax exhibited must be the bonafide produce of the exhibitors own bees.
14. The winner of a Perpetual Cup, Tray or Trophy may retain it until the date of the Show of the succeeding year, on which date he/she will return it cleaned, polished and in good order and condition, to the Secretary of The Royal County Beekeepers Association Honey Show Committee. All Cups etc. shall remain the property of The Royal County Beekeepers Association. Should any cup or trophy become damaged or lost during the time in which it is in the possession of the winner, such winner shall pay the show committee a sum of money to be decided by the committee. The winner shall sign a statement to that effect.



Directions

The Community Centre Navan is located in the grounds of St. Mary's Church on Trimgate Street. There is a large car park opposite the rear gate of the church at Fair Green. Parking is limited in the church grounds. There is a one-way traffic system in Navan town centre. See map for details:

Directions to Car Park.

- Coming from the N2 (North) follow signs to Collon / Slane / Navan. After Slane, this road will come to a roundabout at the "Round O" pub. Follow signs for Town Centre / Dublin (N51). At the junction with the Kells Road (N3) turn left towards Dublin (river on your left). Turn right at 3rd set of traffic lights (N51 to Trim). Straight ahead. Car park visible on the right. Turn right onto Fair Green.
- Coming from Dublin direction follow the N3/M3 straight to Navan. Exit 8 on M3 and follow directions to Navan. Turn left at traffic lights, N51 (direction Trim). Straight ahead. Car park visible on the right. Turn right onto Fair Green.
- Coming from Trim direction at the Railway Street roundabout take the 3rd exit. Turn left onto Fair Green.

There is also on street parking available in Navan Town Centre.
